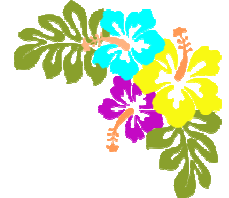


Countryside's Annual Labor Day Picnic

Recap of Board Meeting Minutes for April - July



April: The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM on April 8, 2014 in the Countryside Recreation Room. The March minutes and the Treasurer's Report were reviewed and approved by the Board. The General Manager reported that the sand in the wading pool filter was replaced and Valley Oasis Pools



completed the pool resurfacing. Some structural cracks were found in the pool around the light fixtures and pool floor returns. There was an additional cost of \$6,134.23 to make repairs. Pima County Elections Department contacted the General Manager and they agreed on a fee for the use of the recreation room for election day. The Board approved a change to the collection procedures to reduce postage cost. A motion was approved to spend \$1,787.60 to purchase twelve chaise lounges for the pool area. The Easter egg hunt is scheduled for April 19th. There will be swim lessons this summer starting the first week of June. Seven members were sent to Brown, Olcott, PLLC for collection. Deanna Cross from the Social Media Network, Next Door, made a presentation to the Board regarding her Agency. Next Board of Director's meeting is scheduled for June 10, 2014.

May: No meeting scheduled for May.

June: The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM on June 10, 2014 in the Countryside Recreation Room. The April minutes and the April and May Treasurer's Reports were reviewed and approved by the Board. The Board was given an update of the accounts that were referred to Brown, Olcott, PLLC for collection. The chaise lounge order was delivered. Lifeguards are scheduled to start on May 24th and summer hours will be 7:00AM to 10:00PM. One hundred and twenty-five members attended the Easter Egg Hunt in April. The Board approved a motion to repair the electrical conduit and run new wiring for the pool lights on the west side of the pool, funds to come from the reserve account "Lighting". The Board instructed the General Manager to look into upgrading the light fixtures and possibly adding sky lights in the recreation room. Recreation room baseboards will be repaired after water issues are corrected. A member requested a TV for the fitness room. The Board could not justify the expense of running a new cable line to the room. Two members requested another exercise bike in the fitness room. The Board approved the purchase of another bike, since there were originally two exercise bikes in the fitness room. A member suggested having a community garden at the Center. The Board felt that the Center didn't have the resources for this type of activity. The next Board of Director's meeting is scheduled for July 8, 2014.

July: The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM on July 8, 2014 in the Countryside Recreation Room. The June minutes and the Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved by the Board. The Board reviewed a list of delinquent accounts that are being sent to Phil Brown for collection. The final payment was released for the rewiring of the west side of the pool. At the August meeting the General Manager will provide shading options for the small playground and pool area. A member requested a rowing machine for the fitness room. The General Manager and Board secretary will measure the area in the fitness room and determine if there is room, a decision will be made at the August Board meeting. The next Board of Director's meeting is scheduled for August 12, 2014 in the Countryside Community Club Recreation Room at 7:00PM

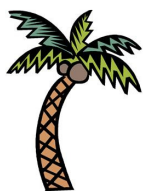
