Working on the board can be an enriching experience and can help you make lasting, positive changes to the Community Club for your friends, family & neighbors.

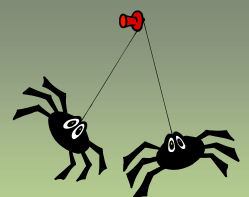
